Dear Parents and Carers of Class 2 and 3 Children,

Next term, Class 2 and 3's topic will be 'Under the Sea'. To get this topic off to an amazing start, we have been fortunate enough to secure an exciting trip to Hull! This will take place on **Tuesday 9th January**. During the day, we will visit the Deep to explore coral reefs and look at all sorts of creatures that live under the sea and also the Maritime museum where we see a whale skeleton and ship models.

Staff accompanying the trip are: Mrs Morris, Miss Hooke, Mrs Kay, Miss Handford, Mrs Lovelock and Mr Dawson. We have four places available for adult helpers – two from Class 2 and two from Class 3. If you would like to join us, please indicate on the reply slip below and we will let you know whether we are able to take you as soon as we can.

In order to pack all of this in, there will need to be an earlier start. Children will need to arrive at school **no later than 8:15am** as the coach will be leaving at 8:30am. On arrival at school, children will be registered and have the opportunity to go to the toilet. If your child requires any travel sickness medication, please ensure they take this before leaving home. Any medication required for the journey home will need to be provided in a named envelope with a completed medicine form. This **must** be handed to staff on arrival at school. We aim to be back at school no later than 5:30pm. Upon leaving Hull, we will contact school with an estimated arrival time which will be put on the school website and the usual social media sites.

Your child will need a packed lunch. If your child has paid for hot school meals, school will provide a packed lunch. As we will be a little arriving back at school, please also provide a 'mess free' snack to have on the journey home. Pupils on hot school meals, who would prefer to provide their own packed lunch, please indicate on the reply slip below. As this will be a longer day than usual, please ensure that your child has plenty of drink available (no fizzy drinks). Where possible, please make lunches disposable.

Children will need to wear their school uniform including a jumper and bring a coat in case of bad weather as we will be walking between the two different venues. A book may be brought to read on the coach but we would ask that children do not bring any electronic devices including phones.

The cost of the trip is £15 per child which includes coach travel and all entry fees to the Deep and Maritime museum.

Please return **permission slips** to class teachers as soon as possible and no later than Friday 5th January 2018. This is particularly important if your child requires a school packed lunch.

Payment for the trip should be made by Friday 12th January.

We are looking forward to an amazing day out which will really spark the children's interest and enthusiasm in this new topic. Should you require any further information, please do not hesitate to contact us at school.
