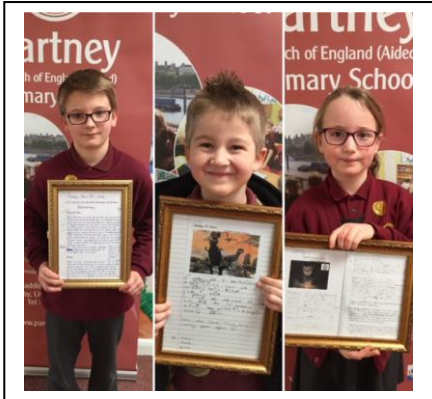

It was the last Golden Assembly today as we will be having our Easter Service on Wednesday afternoon at 1.30pm at St Nicholas Church in Partney.



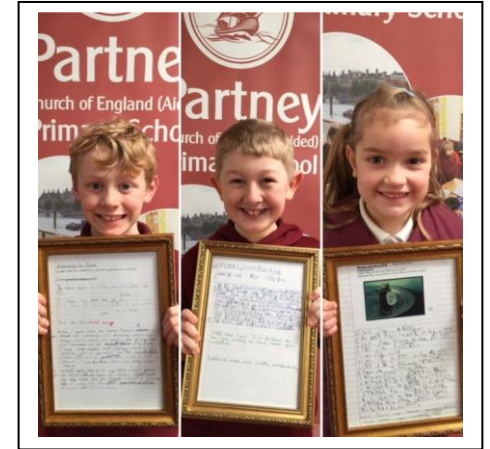
### Golden Writers!
