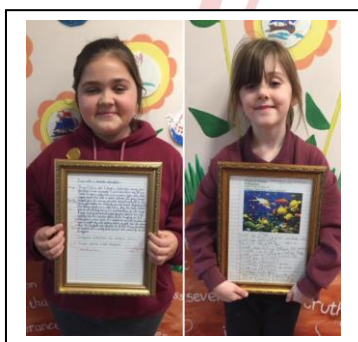
Newsletter – Friday 24th November 2017
