Substantial fundraising is required for alterations to the EYSF canopy to enable it to be used more. Initial quotes in region of £16,000. Possibility of Lottery Grant for part of cost. Proportion of money transferred from PFA into School Fund to be ring-fenced for this project. To approach local businesses for support.

It was agreed that PFA would pay for break-time fruit for KS2 children, costing (update) £112 for remainder of financial year (March 2018) , if school is unable to provide. Tesco can supply out of date fruit weekly, but would need collection.
