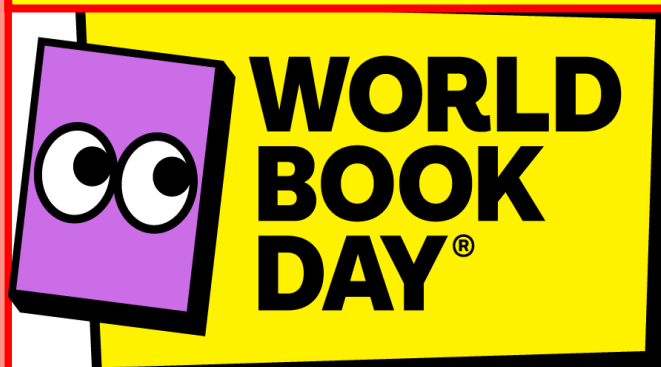
Attendance Update
